

**REGULATIONS FOR THE VAUDREUIL-SOULANGES PALLIATIVE CARE RESIDENCE'S 2025
"YOUR PASSPORT TO TRAVEL" LOTTERY
(RACJ-L02555)**

TICKETS:

Tickets for the "Your Passport to Travel" lottery are sold at a cost of \$100 each and will be available for purchase until October 9th, 2025, at 5:00 p.m.

After purchasing a ticket, the buyer must enter the following information on the detachable coupon: complete name, home address, phone number and email address.

Only 1,000 tickets, numbered from 0001 to 1000, are printed. Eligible participants can purchase an unlimited number of tickets, subject to availability.

DRAW DATE:

The draw will be held on October 10th, 2025, at 11:00 a.m. at the Vaudreuil-Soulanges Palliative Care Residence, located at 90 Como Gardens, Hudson (Quebec) J0P 1H0. The draw will be broadcast on FB live and recorded.

During this random draw, ticket holders will have a chance to win one of the 4 following prizes:

- 4th Draw: Travel voucher worth: \$10,000 (or \$8,000 in cash)**
- 3th Draw: Travel voucher worth: \$5,000**
- 2nd Draw: Travel voucher worth: \$5,000**
- 1st Draw: Travel voucher worth: \$5,000**

The winner of the fourth draw will have the option of choosing a travel voucher worth \$10,000 or a sum of \$8,000 in cash. If the winner opts for the cash prize, the VSPCR will pay him/her the amount of \$8,000. The winner will have 15 days from the date of the draw to decide between a travel voucher or cash prize.

LIMITATION: Once it has been picked, a winning ticket will not be put back in with the other tickets for a subsequent draw. However, a person who has purchased several tickets may be the winner of another prize, even if he/she is already the winner of a prize previously awarded in the draw.

The vouchers have no expiration date and, as such, there are no restrictions regarding travel dates.

Those who purchase physical tickets must fill out the detachable coupon.

Tickets may only be purchased by those ages 18 and up. Tickets cannot be purchased on behalf of a minor. The Licensee's liability is limited to the purchase price of the ticket.

All winners must provide two (2) pieces of i.d. on which the information matches the information provided on the detachable coupon and consent to having their name and photo used by the licensee for publicity purposes. The total combined value of the prizes is \$25,000.
