

LES BEAUX 4H FONDATION MARTIN-MATTE 2026

When: Saturday, February 7, 2026

CONCEPT & CHALLENGE

Les Beaux 4h Fondation Martin-Matte is a major fundraising event. You are invited to form a team of 4 walkers. Teams will challenge themselves to raise the highest amount in donations. Each participant must pay a registration fee of \$50 (\$40 if registered before midnight on December 19, 2025) to confirm their participation.

In addition:

Each adult team must raise a minimum of \$1,300, which comes to \$325 per participant (including the registration fee).

Each youth team (ages 12 to 17) must raise a minimum of \$700, or \$175 per participant (including the registration fee).

Teams that have not reached the required fundraising amounts will not be able to receive their race bibs or the items provided for the event.

Funds raised will go toward improving the quality of life for people living with traumatic brain injuries or physical disabilities. Donors will receive a charitable tax receipt for any donation over \$20. This walk is open to all fitness levels and is designed to be a friendly, festive, and safe event.

GOAL

Raise \$750,000 to support projects that will improve the quality of life for children and adults living with a traumatic brain injury or physical disability.

TEAMS

Teams must be made up of four participants aged 12 and older, including one team captain, who is responsible for completing team registration. A maximum of two supporters can also be added to the team. Supporters are allowed to help with fundraising.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY

Upon registration, each participant aged 16 and older must read and approve the "Accident Liability Waiver" before clicking "Submit."

For participants under the age of 16, this waiver will be included in the confirmation email. It must be duly completed and signed by a parent or legal guardian, and returned by email to the Fondation Martin-Matte. Without a signed waiver, the child will not be allowed to participate in the challenge.

MINIMUM FUNDRAISING REQUIREMENT

Teams of 4 adults must raise a minimum of \$1,300. This amount includes the \$50 registration fee per participant (\$40 if registered before midnight on December 19, 2025). The more your team raises, the greater your chances of winning one of the amazing prizes offered through the rewards program.

Participants aged 12 to 17 have a minimum fundraising goal of \$175 per person, which equals \$700 for a team of four.

The total fundraising goal for a team depends on the amount required per participant, based on age. For example, a team made up of 2 adults and 2 youth participants will have a minimum fundraising goal of \$1,000.

Please note: Teams will not receive their race bibs or the partner gift items until the required fundraising amounts have been met.

FUNDRAISING COMPETITION

The total amount of donations collected will determine the winning team of *Les Beaux 4h Fondation Martin-Matte* marathon. To be counted, all donations must be received and recorded by Saturday, February 7, 2026, at 3:00 PM. Please note that while the Fondation Martin-Matte will continue to accept donations after this deadline, they will not be counted toward the fundraising competition. Cash and cheque donations will be accepted at registration, throughout the evening, and during the fundraising period. - Stay on the marked course
- Do not block sidewalks or traffic
- In case of an accident, remain on-site and notify the organizers
- No alcohol or drug use before or during the walk
